- 1. The website automatically collects only the information contained in cookies.
- 2. Files (Cookies) are text files stored in the website user's Data Terminal Equipment and are intended for using the website pages. Cookies contain first of all the name of the website from which they originate, their unique number and the storage time on the Data Terminal Equipment.
- 3. The operator of the service is the entity posting on the terminal device the cookie files of the user and having an access to them.
- 4. The website Operator uses files (cookies) in order to:

adapt the content of the website to the individual preferences of the user, in particular the files recognize their device in order to display the page according to their preferences; prepare statistics that help to know the preferences and behaviour of users - the analysis of these statistics is anonymous and allows one to customize the content and appearance of the site to the prevailing trends; statistics are also used to assess the popularity of the site, to enable logging onto the website and to maintain the user's login on each subsequent page of the website.

- 5. The website uses two main types of files (cookies) session and permanent. Session files are temporary, they are stored until one leaves the site (by entering another page, logging out or turning off the browser). Fixed files are stored on one's device terminal user until they are removed by the user, or due to passing a period of time resulting from their settings.
- 6. The user can change your browser settings at any time to block the use of cookies or to obtain information about their placement in the user's device. Other available options can be checked in the settings of one's web browser. Note that most browsers are set to accept saving cookie files by default on the terminal device.
- 7. The operator of the service informs that changes to the settings in the user's web browser may restrict an access to certain features of the website.
- 8. The cookie files used by the website (placed in the terminal device of the user) may be made available to its partners and the advertiser who co-works with it.
- 9. The information regarding web browser settings is available in the browser's menu (help) or on its producer's website.
